

Can I still go to university if I do the ACCESS pathway?

- Yes, with successful completion of a Certificate IV course and STAT English assessment (after Year 12 completion) or ATAR English
- There are also options to apply for some courses based on a portfolio of work and an interview.

What if I change my mind and want to do a different course or pathway?

- You have the opportunity to change a course at the end of each semester in Year 11 and in Term 1 of Year 12.
- Some students do move from the ATAR to ACCESS pathway at the end of Semester 1 or 2 in Year 11. This requires an interview with yourself, a Careers Counsellor and your parents.

Are there any courses that I must study for the WACE?

- Yes:
 - o English (ATAR or General) or Literature (ATAR)
 - o Religion and Life (ATAR or General)
 - o At least 1 List B course see above
- If you are doing ACCESS pathway, you must select General Career and Enterprise

<u>Note:</u> If you select General Religion and Life with the ATAR pathway, you may not be able to change to only 5 courses in Year 12.

How do I make my Course Selections?

- 1. Decide on a WACE pathway ATAR or ACCESS
- 2. Select 6 courses based on interests, strengths and future goals.
- 3. Refer to Course Recommendations sheet emailed at end of Term 2
- 4. Check that you meet the Year 10 grade prerequisites on Semester 1 Report*
- 5. Ensure that you have:
 - selected Religion and Life ATAR or General
 - selected English and/or Literature ATAR or General
 - At least one List B course included
 - Selected G-Career & Enterprise if doing the ACCESS pathway
- 6. Discuss your selections with parents, teachers and Course Counsellor.
- 7. Enter selections into EDVAL choices by Wednesday 19 July.

Note: **Course selections may be changed until beginning of Year 11 2024,** <u>depending on class sizes and</u> with permission of Deputy Principal, Teaching and Learning.

What if I do not meet the grade prerequisite to study a course?

- 1. You will not be permitted to select the course in your initial course selections. However, your counsellor will indicate your desire to study another course on your course counselling notes.
- 2. At the end of Term 4, your grades will be reviewed and if you have met the prerequisite, your selections may be changed to include the desired course.

Which TAFE Certificates can I complete through ACCESS?

- There are many Certificate courses available, and our Careers staff work with students to find the best certificate to suit their interests.
- Some TAFE certificates commence in Year 11 and take two years to complete; others commence in Year 12 and take one year to complete.
- Please refer to the ACCESS Information brochure provided for a list of possible certificate courses.


